
- Avoid self-sabotage: Stop being subconsciously pulled back into the past and repeating self-limiting behaviour. Learn to manage your emotions and actions.

THE AUTHOR

Barabian foster family. She was the pioneering batch of Malay-educated students to enter Singapore University in English and graduated among the top students of her cohort in 1970.

She rejected a post-graduate scholarship conditioned by childhood limiting beliefs and joined the national broadcasting station instead. Producing current affairs programmes in Singapore's developmental journalism under the government of Prime Minister Lee Kuan Yew, she was approached to join the elite Administrative Service in the Prime Minister's Office, and to serve in the ruling People's Action Party and possibly become a Member of Parliament (MP). She turned it down again, influenced by her self-limiting beliefs. She continued with professional training in Radio Netherlands Training Centre (RNTC), BBC London and the Australian Broadcasting Corporation.

Thirty-five years of broadcasting has exposed Zainab to the best and brightest in the nation and beyond. It pushed her towards self-development courses other than Sociology, Psychology and Economics. Determined to clear her mental block that conditioned her life, she went for courses on the working of the mind and emotions to free herself of her subjugated past.

Married to a Malay gentleman whose family originated from Java, Indonesia, her life story is a microcosm of Singapore's multiracial nation. Inspired by bold and visionary leadership, she pushed boundaries for her Malay-language team to win the New York Radio Festival Award in 2001. Her son won international Asian Financial Leadership Award in 2016 while her daughter won the Shell-Singapore Dance Theatre



(SDT) scholarship. In retirement, she worked as a counsellor- trainer with Citibank-Tsao Foundation in financial and relationship courses sharing her experience with the above 40s.

Zainab does not want her life's lessons to languish in the mist of time. It is a legacy of Singapore's past collective experience as the millennials face an increasingly challenging tomorrow of the COVID-19.

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
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
